

WEDDING SHOW VISITORS COVID 19 GUIDELINES

Please pre-register for all shows you may wish to attend. If you just turn up on the day you could have a longer waiting time or even find we are unable to allow you entry.

At some shows due to demand, you may be given a time slot to attend. Please adhere to this as it forms part of our Government Guidelines and we must control numbers at all times in each room. If you are unable to attend, please let us know beforehand if you can.

Please do not attend if you have a temperature, cough or any other known Covid 19 symptoms. Also please do not attend if you have recently travelled to any counties where quarantine is required if you are still within the quarantine period.

We regret that due to the number restrictions allowed in rooms at most shows you may only bring one other person with you. So only 2 people in each party may attend. However, at some shows we may only allow one person due to demand. Please do not bring children to the show.

ALL VISITORS MUST WEAR A FACE MASK AT ALL TIMES DURING THE SHOW. You will not be allowed admittance without one.

On arrival at the show please ensure you are wearing your face mask before you approach the registration desk. We will register that you have arrived and allow you access as soon as numbers permit. **PLEASE USE THE HAND SANITISER BEFORE YOU ENTER THE EXHIBITION ROOMS.** We will do our best to keep things running smoothly but please be patient if you have to wait. You will be offered a free carrier bag and a copy of Absolute Bridal magazine to collect yourself before you are allowed to enter the exhibition rooms. These will not long be pre-packed in the interest of safety.

There will be a strict one-way system in place, and you may not turn back at any time. If you wish to visit a stand you have passed, please continue around the exhibition and then return to the registration desk, via the exit, to request re-admittance. Please follow the signage and please keep 2 M apart or a minimum 1 M if you are at an exhibitors' stand. Our exhibitors' will remain behind their stands in order to allow the 1 M distance. **PLEASE** do not touch anything on exhibition stands without asking the exhibitor first. Items will need to be sanitised after you have touched them and not all items can be.

Only one household at a time may visit an exhibitors' stand. If a stand is busy you may wait at a 2 M distance in the aisle for your turn provided that this does not cause a pinch point that does not allow social distancing within the guidelines set.

Please only leave at the indicated exit unless the fire alarm goes off when you should leave at the closest exit.
